**Director: Johanna Toia** 

Johanna Toia is the third generation of her family to tread the boards, joining Savoyards as a dancer in the company's production of The Merry Widow in 1965. She went on to perform in a range of operettas and musicals in chorus, minor and major principal roles. Many years of experience in all aspects of performing and production combined with her love of musical theatre made her transition into directing an obvious one. She began her directing career

with South Pacific (Co-Director) and has since gone on to be part of creative teams for Oklahoma! (2005, Director), HMS Pinafore (2007, Director), Cabaret (2007, Assistant Director), 42<sup>nd</sup> Street (2010, Assistant Director), My Fair Lady (2011, Director), Thoroughly Modern Millie (2014, Director), Legally Blonde (2016, Director), The King and I (2017, Director) and Hot Shoe Shuffle (2021, Director).



Musical Director: Nicky Griffith

Nicky Griffith is a conductor, multi-instrumentalist and music teacher. She is the Assistant Conductor of Queensland Youth Orchestras and directs the Instrumental Music - Strings Program at Varsity College. Nicky is a popular engagement at workshop events for young musicians across the Gold Coast and has appeared as guest conductor of the Queensland Youth Symphony at

QPAC and the Old Museum Concert Hall, the Cadenza Chamber Players and in rehearsals for the UQ Symphony Orchestra and the Brisbane Concert Orchestra. Since 2012, Nicky has contributed to over forty musical theatre productions in South-East and North Queensland as musical director, conductor, cellist, bassist, or technical crew. In 2022, she musically directed and conducted Sweeney Todd (Phoenix Ensemble), Charlie and the Chocolate Factory (HOTA), and was assistant musical director and assistant conductor for Les Misérables (Lynch and Paterson). Nicky was musical director and conductor of Hot Shoe Shuffle (Savoyards) in 2021 and assistant musical director and guest conductor of Oklahoma! (Savoyards) in 2019. Currently completing a Master of Music Studies in conducting at the Queensland Conservatorium, Nicky holds a Postgraduate Certificate of Music Studies in Conducting, Bachelor of Music (Honours) and Graduate Diploma in Education.

**Choreographer: Desney Toia-Sinapati** 

With formal training in jazz, tap, classical (Sue Harvey Academy of Modern Stage Dance) and Polynesian dance (Isles of the Pacific Polynesian Dance Troupe), Desney is no stranger to the stage, her debut being at the age of six, cartwheeling across the stage in the 1986 Savoyard's production of Showboat. Since then, she has performed in many shows with credits including roles in

Nunsense (Sister Mary Leo), Anything Goes and Thoroughly Modern Millie. Desney's choreographic credits include Dirty Rotten Scoundrels and Kinky Boots (Phoenix Ensemble) regional work with the Lockyer Regional Performing Arts (Music Man and Bye Bye Birdie), The Sound of Music (Choreographer/Assistant Director, Savoyards), Thoroughly Modern Millie (Speed Tap Routine), and Ensemble Choreographer for the 2014 Ipswich Musical Theatre Company production of The Phantom of the Opera, winner of a 2015 Australia Day Award for Best Community Event in Ipswich. Brisbane choreographic credits also include Savoyards' productions of How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying, the Queensland premiere of Nice Work If You Can Get It; I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change, Chicago and Hot Shoe Shuffle. These productions have received 11 Del Arte Charts recognitions.

Savoyards is committed to producing theatre that reflects the diversity of the local and global community. All roles below are open to all ethnicities, ability, genders, and sexual identities. We especially encourage applications from performers who are differently abled, from diverse ethnic or cultural backgrounds and/or identify as LGBTIQ+.

### Donna - Stage Age 40ish

Vocal Range E3 – A5 (mezzo soprano with a strong belt)

Sophie's mother – Owner of the Taverna – Former lead singer of the Dynamos. Strong, independent, able to portray a wide range of emotions. Sings some of the biggest solos in the show. Needs to be a strong singer and actress as well as able to move well.

#### Tanya – Stage age 40ish

Vocal Range E3 – E5 (strong mezzo soprano belter)

Former singer in the Dynamos. Rich, sophisticated, flirtatious, witty. Has been married a few times. Needs be able to sing and move well.

### Rosie – Stage Age 40ish

Vocal Range E3 – D5 (Strong alto belter)

Former singer in the Dynamos. Down to earth, confident, free spirited. Funny on the outside but covers her shyness. Needs good comic timing and needs to be able to sing and move well.

#### Sophie – Stage age 21

Vocal range F#3 – E5 (pop soprano with a strong belt/mix)

Young, romantic, bright and energetic. Strong but with an underlying vulnerability. Longing for what her mother never had – a traditional family and a father to walk her down the aisle. Needs to be able to sing and move well.

#### Lisa – Stage Age around 21

Vocal Range G3 – Db5 (Mezzo soprano belter)

Sophie's friend and bridesmaid. She is energetic and a bit kooky. Need to be able to sing and dance.

#### Ali – stage age around 21

Vocal range G3 – D5 (Mezzo soprano belter)

Sophie's friend and bridesmaid. Impulsive and energetic with a great sense of fun. Needs to be able to sing and dance.

#### **Sam** – Stage age 45 – 50

Vocal Range D3 - Ab4 (Baritone)

May be Sophie's Father. Charming, successful architect. Confident and composed. Determined not to mess up a possible second chance with Donna. Strong actor able to portray a range of emotions. Able to sing and move reasonably well.

#### Harry – Stage Age 40 +

Vocal Range C#3 – F#4 (Tenor/high baritone)

May be Sophie's Father. English, quirky, conservative but in his younger days known as Harry Head banger. He tries hard to show the Harry of old particularly his spontaneity. Needs to be able to move reasonably well.

#### Bill - Stage age 40 +

Vocal Range Bb2 – F#4 (Baritone)

May be Sophie's father. Travel Book Writer – has avoided the complexities of a relationship. Good natured, hard working, always ready for adventure, funny, needs good comic timing. Needs to be able to move reasonably well.

#### **Sky** – stage age 24 – 27

Vocal Range Eb3 – D5 (tenor)

Sophie's fiancée. Athletic. Attractive, ex businessman helping Donna with upgrading management of the Taverna. Able to move reasonably well.

#### Pepper – Stage Age 24 -27

Vocal range A4 – F5 (tenor/baritone)

Hotel employee, Sky's friend. He is fun, charming and always flirting with the ladies. He takes a specific interest in Tanya. Will need good comic timing. Able to be able to move well.

#### **Eddie** – Stage age 22-29

Vocal Range Tenor/Baritone

Hotel employee. Sky's friend. He shows a good sense of fun but is a little more responsible than Pepper. Also needs to be able to move well.

#### **Ensemble**

A range of island villagers, hotel employees and wedding guests. A wide variety of ages. Everyone will need to be able to move. There will also be specialty dancers. The cameo role of Father Alexandrios who officiates at Sophie's Wedding in the second act will not require a solo audition. During the earlier stages of the show this person can be part of the ensemble.
